MATHS:

*Read and write numbers to 20 (also in words)

*Counting to 50

AT HOME: Practise counting forward and backwards in steps of 1. Make it harder by starting at a different number!

SCIENCE:

Materials: We will identify and describe different materials and choose materials that would be suitable for a Superhero cape.

AT HOME: Can you spot different materials around your house?

Topic: :Real Life Superheroes

We will be learning about people who have been super in their lives such as firefighters and famous heroes such as Florence Nightingale.

AT HOME: Who do you admire and respect? What makes them super?

RE: We will be discussing what it means to belong to a community?

AT HOME: Can you think of any groups or communities that you belong to?

PE:

WE will be covering basic skills this term including throwing catching and travelling.

AT HOME: Practise standing on one leg. Now try the other. Which was easier?
