Dear Parents/Carers

This letter is in answer to recent questions regarding Gloucestershire County Council's strong advice to schools that goggles should not be worn for school swimming sessions. Whilst concern for the health and safety of all children is our main priority, we have taken further advice, and are willing to allow our pupils to wear goggles as long as clear safety rules are followed.

If your child really needs to wear goggles, please support us with the following before school lessons begin:

1. Make sure your child can put on and remove goggles safely, on their own.
2. Reinforce that goggles should not be removed or adjusted during the lesson. This includes resting them on the tops of their heads between instructions. If not, then they will be asked to leave them off for the session.
3. Make sure your child understands that their goggles are their own responsibility and must not be shared with others.

We would appreciate you completing the slip below to say that you have explained this to your child/ren and that you give your consent for your child/ren to wear them. You do not need to respond if your child does not need goggles.
