MATHS:

*Counting to 20 and beyond

*Recognising 1 more or 1 less than a number

*2D shapes - triangles, circles, squares, rectangles, pentagons, hexagons

AT HOME: Practise counting forward and backwards in steps of 1. Make it harder by starting at a different number!

SCIENCE:

Materials: We will identify and describe different materials and choose materials that would be suitable for different uses.
