

# Welcome to Year One

## Topic!

Our topic this term is Superheroes. We will be looking at fantasy and real life superheroes as well as thinking about what makes us special. We are hoping to have a 'Superhero Day' at some point but we will send out details for that in the future.



## PE!

PE lessons will be on a Tuesday. Please come to school in your PE kit with appropriate footwear. PE will be mostly outside so please make sure they are wearing joggers/jumpers if the weather is colder.



## WOW Vouchers

In your child's book bag there should be a few wow vouchers. These can be filled in at home for the children to share with the class back at school. It can be an achievement such as riding a bike, attending ballet lessons, sleeping in their own room, trying new foods or helping others. Any moment that you feel they have done particularly well in is good to share. Every wow voucher earns them a house point too! (Wow vouchers are available to print off the website too).

## Jumpers, Coats etc

Children should have coats in school every day as the weather can be very changeable.

Please remember to **NAME ALL UNIFORM**. It is very difficult to return any item of clothing that does not have a name on.



## Spellings!

Spelling and Reading is the only homework this term. The spelling sheet is attached showing the spellings we would like the children to learn each week up to half term. Although we practise spellings in school, we would really like the children to practise them at home too. The best way is to **LOOK** at them, **COVER** them, then **WRITE** them. Spelling tests are on a Friday.

## Reading!

This is the single most important thing you can do with your child. Reading is key to a lot of the children's learning at this age and therefore daily reading helps them a lot.

In Year One we join the rest of the school with the reading challenge. We check how many times the children have read each Friday and get a percentage of how many children have read 3 times or more. The winning class gets a special reading treat. Our aim is always 100% so please read with your child and record it in the yellow reading diary.

Your child's reading books will be changed on a Monday when they will be given 4 reading books for the week. Please leave these books and yellow reading diary in their book bags as we often read with the children at school too.

Library books will be changed on a Monday also. This will be recorded in the back of their yellow reading diaries.

We have included a booklet to support reading at home that I hope you find useful.
