AT HOME: Set a timer to go off every hour throughout the day (on the o'clock). Where are the hands on the clock?

AT HOME: Can you think of any groups or communities that you belong to?

SCIENCE:

Materials: We will identify and describe different materials and choose materials that would be suitable for different uses.
